Key Stage Four Curriculum Overview

In KS4 students explore Physical Geography through the study of a diverse range of topics including Natural Hazards, Tropical Rainforests, Ecosystems, Weather and Climate change. This is taught using case studies and real life events with an application of that knowledge through exam question techniques. In Human geography students investigate issues surrounding resource management, overpopulation, megacities and urban issues and challenges, this helps students learn about their environment and people's impact upon it.

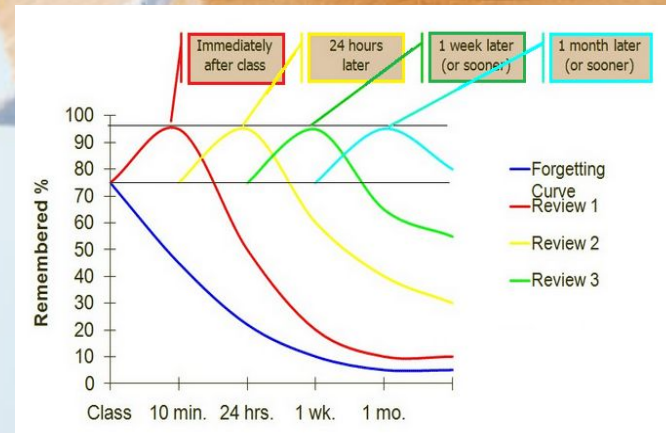

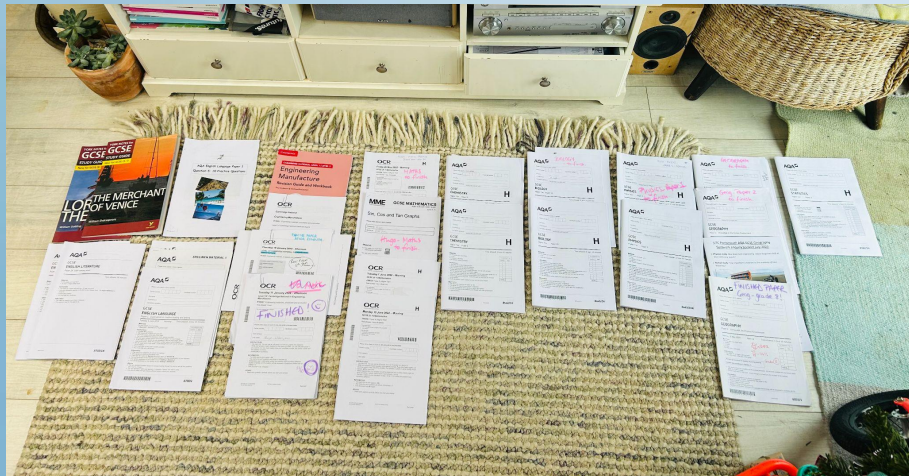
