Uniform

It is compulsory for all students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 to wear the Bourne Community College uniform.

Full and correct uniform is expected at all times and should be worn in an appropriate manner. Please refer to the uniform policy on our website for full uniform expectations.

Please support your child to adhere to the Bourne Community College school uniform policy by ensuring that correct uniform is worn every day. All clothing should be clearly labelled with the student's name.

Compulsory for all years

- School blazer - navy blue with school logo
- Smart, black **school trousers** (covering the ankle) or
- Tartan pleated skirt; a navy blue skirt purchased from Skoolkit may be worn as an alternative in **Year 11 only**.
- Plain pastel blue shirt or blouse, fully buttoned and tucked in (T shirts must not be visibly worn underneath)
- School tie (to be worn with shirts)
- Plain black or navy socks or tights
- Plain ALL BLACK flat, **full shoe** which can be polished.
- Coat for bad weather - to be worn over the school blazer

Optional

- Plain navy blue jumper with or without the school logo

Shoes

- Shoes must be all black, flat, polishable and formal in style. They must provide adequate support and protection. Skate shoes, canvas shoes, boots, branded trainers or shoes with coloured piping or logos

School Bag

An appropriate school bag, large enough to hold an A4 folder and appropriate equipment, must be brought to school every day. A rucksack is recommended. Handbags are not permitted.

PE KIT

Compulsory

- Plain, black/navy **sports** shorts (cycling shorts are not permitted)
- White PE top with Bourne logo (available from Skoolkit)
- Appropriate and supportive sports trainers (pumps, Converse or fashion shoes/trainers are not permitted)

Optional

- Black/Navy training skort
- Plain black/Navy **sports** leggings/tracksuit bottoms
- Plain black overtop (hoodies are not permitted)

GCSE PE Groups

Students studying GCSE PE will be required to purchase a navy blue Bourne Community College polo shirt

Clarification of Uniform and Appearance

Clothing/footwear

- Hoodies are not permitted - students should wear coats in cold weather

Hair

- Hair must be of a natural colour and be neat in appearance. Accessories must be small, discrete navy or black
- This means no 'pattern cuts', shaved, dip dyed, ombre or excessively coloured hair. Any completely shaven or patterned shaven head is unacceptable

Make-up

- Make-up must be minimal and discreet
- False eyelashes, nail varnish or acrylic nails are not permitted in school and will need to be removed

Jewellery

- Only one pair of small, plain ear studs may be worn and a watch
- No other jewellery is permitted. Stretch earrings/spikes or any other kind of earring are not permitted. No other body piercings should be worn, including nose, upper ear, eyebrow or tongue.
- Piercings (other than mentioned above) and including nose studs and/or tattoos are not permitted under any circumstances

The College will not take responsibility for any items brought onto the premises. If items are worn that do not meet the College uniform rules they will be confiscated and can be collected at the end of the school day. Repeated confiscations will require parent collection.
